Please find below some important logistical information to ensure that your planning is as seamless as possible.

CAPE TOWN IN A NUTSHELL

Cape Town : Colloquially named the Mother City.

Cape Town, South Africa's second-largest city, ranks among the most beautiful in the world. With its larger-than-life mountain overlooking the City Bowl, harbour, white beaches and Robben Island beyond, this is a tourist's playground. Two World Heritage Sites, the sprawling Winelands, untouched nature reserves, beautiful botanic gardens and a buzzing waterfront are just the start of your adventure when you visit this special city.

With a population of 3.7 million, Cape Town is South Africa's second most populous city, a quintessential melting pot of creativity, cuisine and colour. Its strategic geographic position at the tip of Africa has seen foreign visitors stopping off at the Cape since the 1400s, each contributing unique cultural influences that make up the fabric of modern-day Cape Town.



SOUTH AFRICA IS A DEVELOPED COUNTRY

In fact, you'll find everything from paved roads and highways to gourmet restaurants, five-star hotels, farmers' markets, museums, and malls here. And while it might be exhilarating to picture a plethora of wild animals roaming the streets, don't expect to share the crosswalk with any lions, elephants, or giraffes. While some villages that border game reserves have to deal with the occasional predator stalking their cattle, you won't spot any wild animals outside the safari.

GETTING THERE

South Africa is serviced by many of the world's major airlines with direct flights throughout Africa, Europe, America and the Middle East on a daily basis. South Africa's three main gateway airports are:

- Cape Town International Airport
- Oliver Tambo International Airport previously known as Johannesburg International Airport
- King Shaka International Airport previously known as Durban International Airport
- Uber is available in Cape Town, Johannesburg and Durban



CELL PHONE COVERAGE AREAS ARE ON POINT

Worried that your trip to South Africa means you'll be unplugged from friends and family back home? Don't be. The coverage in South Africa is vast. If you get a local SIM, data plans and minutes are often capped, though incoming calls are free.



ELECTRICITY IN SOUTH AFRICA

The power supply in South Africa is 220/230 volts AC. The standard plug in South Africa is the 15-amp round-pin, three-prong plug. Euro- and US-style two-pin plugs, and UK-style three-pin plugs, can be used with an adaptor, available at supermarkets; bring transformers along for larger appliances where necessary. Most hotels have 110-volt outlets for electric shavers.



MONEY

The V&A Waterfront is a mere 2.9km from the Cape Town International Convention Centre. You will find several banks, ATMS and Bureaux de Change facilities in the shopping mall.

An Automated Teller Machine (ATM) is available on site at the CTICC.

CAPE TOWN WEATHER

March is the sweet spot in Cape Town's year. The average daily temperatures are 16oC – 27oC (61oF – 80oF). There are a few chilly days when you'll need a light jacket, but most days are a mild 21°C (70°F).



GETTING TO THE VENUE

The Cape Town International Convention Centre (CTICC) Convention Square, 1 Lower Long Street, Cape Town

FROM THE AIRPORT approx 21km - (20 minutes)

- Exit the airport and continue for approximately 3km (stay right).
- Merge onto the N2 Highway.
- Follow N2 Stad / City signs.
- After approximately 18km move into the lane with M6 / Seapoint / Waterfront sign.
- Turn left at traffic light into Walter Sisulu Road
- Drive on – the entrance to the CTICC will be on your left.
- FROM V&A WATERFRONT
- Go along Port Road which will lead you onto Dock Road.
- Continue along Dock Road until you reach Walter Sisulu Road.
- The CTICC will be on your left on Walter Sisulu Road.
